Day 1 | Depart Los Angeles

Day 9 | Port Vila, Vanuatu

Port Vila the capital of Vanuatu, situated around a magnificent natural harbor offering stunning views of Iririki and Ifira islands. The island comprises of a rugged coastline, rolling lush countryside and cascading waterfalls. Vanuatu is a relatively new republic, having achieved independence from France and Britain in 1988, and has a mixture of cultures providing a multitude of dining options, including French, Vietnamese, Chinese, Japanese, Italian, Mexican, Thai, Melanesian and Mediterranean. Day 13 | Savu Savu, Fiji

Coconut palms and old copra plantations line the southern shore. Submerge in the Volcanic Hot Springs, snorkel or dive and see some of the most spectacular marine life or indulge at J. Day 14 | Dravuni Island, Fiji

Dravuni Island is a dramatically rugged volcanic island in the scenic Kadavu group of islands, with a charming village that shelters beneath tall palm trees. Providing near perfect weather both day and night, giving visitors the opportunity to take an adventurous hike up the grassy slopes of the islands highest peak showcasing fantastic views of the surrounding islands. Day 19 | Disembark Cruise Sydney, Australia - Auckland, New Zealand

Today your cruise concludes early morning, disembark the ship and transfer to Sydney airport for your onward journey to Auckland, New Zealand. Auckland, known as the 'city of sails', is New Zealand's largest city and lies across a 7-mile wide volcanic isthmus separating two harbors. Tonight take a stroll along the picturesque waterfront and enjoy the outstanding food and wine, great shopping and exciting nightlife the city has to offer. *Auckland, SkyCity hotel for 1 night (B)*

Day 20 | Auckland - Rotorua, New Zealand

As you leave the City of Sails, head south to Waitomo Glow-Worm Caves passing through Rangiriri, which was once the site of a Maori fort. At Waitomo, enjoy a guided tour through the long galleries, lofty chambers and see stalactites that have formed over thousands of years. Take a small boat ride through the glow-worm grotto that is illuminated by thousands of tiny lights emitted by glow-worms suspended from the cave ceiling. On arrival into Rotorua check in to

your hotel. Later this afternoon you will be collected from your hotel to be lead back to pre-European times with stories, history and protocols of the Maori people. Travel to their Maori village, set deep in the forest and experience a traditional Powhiri (welcome ceremony), enter the traditional village, see the meeting house and learn about the culture through performances and songs. To conclude the evening, you will enjoy a traditionally cooked feast (Hangi) from our earthen ovens. *Rotorua, Millennium Hotel for 2 nights (B, L, D)*

Get a taste of New Zealand's agricultural industry with a sheep shearing display and sheep dog trials at the Agrodome before travelling up the Skyline Gondola and enjoy stunning views over Rotorua whilst lunching at the Skyline restaurant. This afternoon is at leisure to further explore Rotorua or relax in one of the Polynesian spas. (B, L)

Day 22 | Rotorua - Queenstown, New Zealand

After breakfast, transfer to Rotorua airport for your onward flight to Queenstown, the adventure capital of New Zealand. Set on the shores of Lake Wakatipu and surrounded by The Remarkables mountain range. Take time to meander through the streets of the city enjoying the spectacular scenery everywhere you turn from the shoreline of Lake Wakatipu to the cobbled streets of the city. *Queenstown, Heritage Queenstown for 2 nights (B)*

Following a short walk the first animal viewing site is reached, this is where you can see a large breeding colony of New Zealand Fur Seals. From here take a short walk to the yellow eyed penguin conservation area where the penguins arrive from the ocean following their days fishing, and see the Hooker's Sea lions at the beach, both creatures represent the rarest of their kind. (B)

Day 26 | Depart New Zealand - Los Angeles

Farewell New Zealand and the South Pacific at the end of your journey. Transfer to Auckland airport for your flight to Los Angeles. (B)
