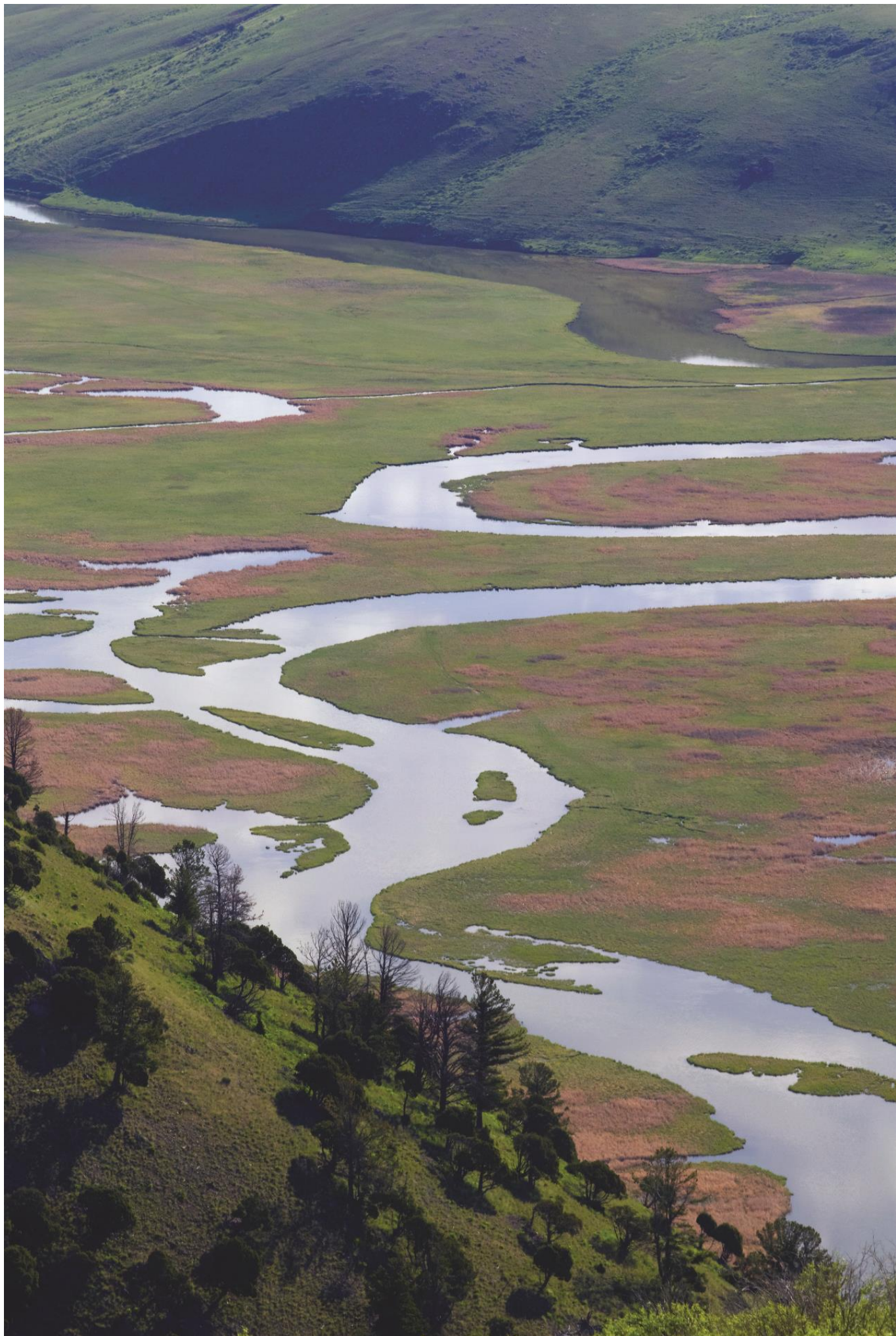
Jackson Hole is located in the southern half of the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. This ecosystem is comprised of a huge expanse of mountains, meadows, sage flats, river bottoms, national forests, and wildlife refuges including both Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks. We are also located in the middle of the largest contiguous forest in the United States.

In the summer, warm days and cool nights can be expected. Mountain and valley hiking trails wind through a world dressed in wildflowers. Wildlife abounds, including bison, elk, mule deer, moose, pronghorn antelope, grizzly and black bears, coyotes, wolves, bald eagles, and more.

## Discover the National Parks

### **Amangani Signature Wildlife Tour *All Year***

A trip to Amangani and Jackson Hole would not be complete without experiencing our Signature Tours. At Amangani, we offer in-house guided wildlife safaris, tours of Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks, as well as butte-top hikes. Any of these activities would be the perfect start to an Amangani vacation, learning first-hand about the area while also becoming acclimated to our mountainous environment.

Enjoy a wildlife expedition through the pristine valley of Jackson Hole with an experienced guide who will introduce you to the fantastic array of wildlife in the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. Your Guest Manager will be able to arrange a guide to fit your needs. While on your trip, be on the lookout for big game like moose, elk, bison, wolves and bears. Also, keep an eye out for the 300 species of birds found in Jackson Hole, including bald eagles, mountain bluebirds, trumpeter swans and sandhill cranes.

Grand Teton National Park statistically is our nation's number one National Park for wildlife observation and can be booked as a half-day tour or three-quarter day. A Yellowstone National Park tour will constitute a full-day tour and be teaming with not only an abundance wildlife but explore vast geological wonders as well.

## Discover the National Parks

### **Yellowstone & Grand Teton National Parks** *May - November*

Jackson serves as a great base for short excursions or all day adventures to Grand Teton National park. Visit scenic Jenny Lake and Jackson Lake for amazing views and great hiking. At least one full day should be spent in Yellowstone, the world's first national park. Sprawling across volcanic plateaus in the northwest corner of Wyoming, Yellowstone contains more than two million acres of crystalline lakes, thundering waterfalls, panoramic vistas and steaming geysers including Old Faithful. When exploring the park, let our Guest Managers arrange an Amangani wildlife guide to accompany and enhance an already fantastic experience.

- Touring Yellowstone will require a full day. We suggest getting an early morning start and touring the "Lower Loop" of the park.
- If you go on your own, be sure to take some snacks and beverages. We would be happy to arrange a picnic basket for your trip.
- Bring extra layers of clothing since weather can change suddenly.
- Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks typically open in May and close early November.

### **Horseback Riding In Jackson Hole** *Mid May – Mid October*

A number of horseback riding adventures are available to you during your stay in Jackson Hole. For the beginner, a scenic ride along our East Gros Ventre Butte provides sweeping views of the majestic Tetons and the town of Jackson. Other options allow you to catch the spirit of the Rocky Mountain West on a horseback ride through the more distant wilderness.

- One hour, two hour, half day and full day trips are available, and due to trail conditions, most are slow trail riding. Your Guest Manager Team can assist you in choosing a trip that is appropriate for your interests and riding ability.
- Please wear closed-toe shoes and bring extra layers in case of changing weather.
- Please wear a hat and sunscreen to protect your face from the sun.
- Long pants are required.

Via Ferrata is Jackson Hole Mountain Resort's newest outdoor adventure. This memorable experience takes you high above the valley floor, across suspended bridges and along granite walls all with a knowledgeable guide. An assisted climbing activity that is guided through the alpine terrain here at JHMR, Via Ferrata is perfect for families, groups or individuals.

The Bridger-Teton and Targhee National Forests provide an unforgettable backdrop for those who prefer longer hikes and require a guide.

### **Floating In The Tetons By Hot Air Balloon** *May - October*

Hot air ballooning above the valley is an awe-inspiring beginning to the day. Upon launch, you will discover the wonders and serenity of a hot air balloon flight. Soaring over 1,000 feet above the valley floor in total silence, enjoy 360 degree views of the Gros Ventre, Teton, Absaroka and Snake River mountain ranges from the comfort and safety of your group or private balloon basket. Ballooning is only offered in the early morning when winds are calm. Please expect an early start between 6.00AM and 7.00AM.

- Dress in warm layers since this trip starts early in the morning and the sun has not had a chance to warm up the valley.
- Please remember to bring your camera with a strap for this high altitude adventure.
- This activity is very weather dependent. Your Guest Manager Team will check pre-dawn if your trip will commence in the morning.
