DESTINATION: Whether you’re visiting ancient Maya temples, caving, hiking, kayaking or horseback riding, San Ignacio is a great place to chill out, grab some food and drinks, and get ready for another day. And if you want to spend the day here, there are plenty of great shops and friendly people to pass the time with.

Located 67 miles from Belize City is San Ignacio Town, connected by the Hawksworth Bridge to its twin town Santa Elena, San Ignacio is the largest town in the Cayo District and is a base for tourism activities throughout Cayo.

Xunantunich Mayan Ruins - Xunantunich or Maiden of the Rock is situated on the Western Highway across the river from the village of San Jose Succotz.

This major ceremonial center can be reached by ferry daily and it is only 1.5 Kilometer (one mile) from some lovely rapids of the Mopan River.

This Classic Period site provides an impressive view of the entire river valley. The site core occupies only 300 square meters but the periphery covers several square kilometers. El Castillo rises 40 meters above plaza level, making it one of the tallest buildings in Belize. On this structure there are two temples. The lower temple is famous for its large stucco frieze. A mask with larger ears probably represents the sun god. Next to this mask, there is a moon sign with a border of signs representing Venus.

July 3, 2021

Cave Tubing and Ziplining - For the cave tubing part of this adventure, after being outfitted with the necessary equipment, begin a 1-mile (1.6-kilometer) trek through subtropical trails, wade across a shallow portion of the river, and pass through two caves before reaching a stunning lagoon surrounded by steep limestone walls. Along the way, your guide will point out various exotic flora and fauna native to Belize.

Float on an inner tube along the cool waters, illuminated by your headlamp. You will be gently pushed by the current or led by your guide into two large chambers—both impressive sanctuaries used by the Maya for sacrificial rituals. Plunge into darkness and listen to the sounds of the cascading waterfalls and bubbling rapids. Upon exiting the caves, continue floating along the jungle-lined river for approximately 30 minutes before returning to the starting point.

Ziplining takes you soaring through the subtropical jungle canopy from treetop to treetop, giving you a bird's-eye view of the rainforest below. A thrilling adventure, there are five runs at heights ranging up to 80 feet (24 meters). The trip culminates in rappelling down the last tree to the ground for that final adrenaline rush.

Guests are outfitted in seated cable gear and helmets by their guide, and will be instructed on how to traverse from platform to platform and reassured of the numerous safety features implemented. The first run is the shortest, much like a test run, and anyone who does not want to continue can exit at this point. Any type of sports clothing and most shoes are acceptable (no flip-flops or footwear that will drop off while in the air). Be sure to bring a camera to capture the enjoyment!

Cave tubing and ziplining can be done separately as half-day tours.

The tour's duration is 9 AM to 4 PM.

The following is included: transportation to/from the location, park fee, ziplining fee, tour specialist, water, sodas, lunch, tube, and headlamp.

Bring a bathing suit, sunscreen, bug spray, and water shoes.

Transfer from Ka'ana to Placencia – Your resort will transfer you to your Placencia hotel. Please arrange a departure time with the on-site concierge 24 hours prior.

DESTINATION: Known locally as “Barefoot Perfect,” Placencia Peninsula is 16 miles of golden sand, the only golden-sand beaches on mainland Belize. After hanging out on the beach, snorkeling and scuba diving, head into town and get a feel for what a traditional Kriol (Creole) fishing village is like. There are also village restaurants, bars and art galleries. About the only thing Placencia doesn't offer is stress. It's just not allowed here.

Half Day Laughing Bird Caye Snorkeling - This is a pristine faroe reef with deep channels on either side, and is also a famous southern marine park. Here coral pinnacles rise from the bottom inside the main barrier reef creating a haven for hosts of brilliantly colored Caribbean reef species. Apart from the possibility of observing turtles and rays going by, you might want to look at the macro view. Many colorful anemones are home to delicate cleaner shrimp and crabs, and at the right time of year, you can find startlingly beautiful bluebell tunicates.

July 7, 2021

Sunset Cruise - Explore a part of picturesque Placencia that you don't see while driving or walking - cruise the canals leading to the lagoon and then enjoy snacks and wine at anchor on the lagoon while watching the sun set over the Maya Mountains!

Leave from Splash Dive Center's marina site at 4:30 pm and take the inner channel that leads through the mangroves to the canals and the residential sections of Placencia and where Placencians keep their boats. You might even spot a lot on one of the little islands on the lagoon side of Placencia to build your Caribbean dream home! Watch for manatees and tropical birds – evening is a great time for spotting wildlife!

Relax and experience the magic of the sun setting over the Maya Mountains while enjoying a choice of appetizing snacks with a glass or two of wine and a little music. After dinner, cruise back through the mangroves and canals for a charming after dark perspective of Placencia from the water. Arrive back at Splash Dive Center at around 8:00 pm.
