You'll end your morning by the Medieval Marais

This afternoon enjoy a guided tour of the Louvre Museum group tour. This guided tour offers the perfect opportunity to learn about the museum's huge collection and its greatest works of art, such as the Mona Lisa, the Venus de Milo, and the Coronation of Napoleon.

The balace of the day is at leisure to explore the City of Light at your own pace.

Versailles

The evening finishes, around 10pm, and we return to the hotel.
