Meet & Greet at San Jose Int'l Airport - Welcome! - A representative of the Costa Rica board of tourism, Canatur, will meet you after you have cleared immigration and provide you with name tags that identify you as a client of Way to Go Tours. After clearing customs, you will exit the terminal. There, you will see a representative of our destination management company, Destination Costa Rica, holding a placard with your name. You will be presented with your vouchers (except the ones included in your documents) and a general info kit. Pickup times for tours and transfers will be stamped on each voucher.

Please note: pick up times below are approximates. Times are subject to change by suppliers. Please refer to the vouchers provided in country for exact pick up times. If in-country vouchers are printed with a different time than your documents, the times stamped on the vouchers supersede times listed below.

Transfer from San Jose Airport - to San Jose Hotel Outside Valley 30 Mins - You will be picked up upon arrival and privately transferred to Country Inn and Suites in San Jose.

DESTINATION: San José is the capital city of Costa Rica and is by far the largest city in the country. San José's main attractions include the National Theatre, the Gold and Jade Museums, casinos, shopping malls, fabulous restaurants, art exhibits, dance performances, and opera. As far as accommodations, the city has a broad variety ranging from centrally located hotels, some with historic character, to modern suburban retreats surrounded by lush tropical gardens and swimming pools.

Turtle Beach Arrival Day –

6:30 AM

Start your adventure with an early morning pick-up in San José. Absorb the natural beauty of Costa Rica while traveling on a guided tour of the city to the Braulio Carrillo National Park and through the agricultural versatility of the Limón lowlands, including pineapples, rice, cattle, a tour of a banana plantation that It works (closed Sundays) and national holidays) and much more. Times vary depending on the pickup location and much more.

7:30 AM

10:30 AM

Arrival at the port and transfer to the Tortuga boat. Enjoy a scenic walk along the Tortuguero River and the canals of the Tortuguero National Park while traveling to Turtle Beach Lodge.

Explore the most popular tourist attractions in the area, including the town of Tortuguero and visit the National Park office to buy entrance tickets.

1:00 PM

Receive a warm welcome at Turtle Beach Lodge with a fresh and fresh fruit cocktail and a delicious buffet lunch, then settle in your spacious room.

7:00 PM

Buffet dinner at the Turtle Tavern and restaurant by candlelight.

DESTINATION: Tortuguero, which covers 3/4 of Costa Rica's eastern seaboard. There are plenty of wetlands, rivers, lagoons, and canals that serve as a window through which the visitor can admire the amazing flora and fauna, making it a wonderful experience for nature lovers. Along the coast approximately 3000 Green Sea Turtles come to shore each season, between July and October, to lay their eggs. Caymans, monkeys, sloths, toucans, manatees, jaguars, and 405 species of birds abound in the area.

Shuttle Transfer from Guapiles - to Arenal - A shuttle will pick you up and transfer you to Arenal Paraiso.

DESTINATION: Arenal Volcano is approximately 3000 years old and has an elevation of 5500 feet. Though in a resting phase the volcano's geothermal activity heats the local mineral springs.

Surrounded by lush rain forest, the area offers the most touring options. The area is rich in natural attractions; experience thermomineral hot springs, waterfall hikes, horseback riding, birdwatching, biking, and boat tours on the Cano Negro.

The hike begins on the active side of the volcano that takes you through the forest over recent lava flows and to the destroyed area now in the process of regeneration. After your hike enjoy the thermal springs that await at EcoTermals, originating from the hyper-thermal magnesia filled waters, which means that those who visit us in La Fortuna, San Carlos, can delight themselves in the mineral medicinal properties, which thanks to the perfectly and naturally balanced quantities of calcium bicarbonates and magnesium, which have analgesic, anti-inflammatory, and muscle relaxing properties.

Boat Transfer from Arenal to Monteverde - Arenal Lake crossing, half tour – half transfer is an scenic, fast and the newest way to go or come from La Fortuna to the Monteverde area. We start picking everybody from the hotels in La Fortuna for a 30 minutes drive to the Arenal Lake Dam. There we will aboard into a very comfortable and safe pontoon boat for a 30 to 40 minutes (approx.) ride to Río Chiquito, a little town at the other side of the lake. Once at Río Chiquito, we'll leave the boat and make a

short break to strength the legs, after, another 1 hour thirty minutes microbus ride to get to the hotels in the Monteverde area.

Night Walk - For those who wish to observe wonders hidden in the forest after dark we offer guided night hikes. At sunset, 80% of the forest life becomes actives Our naturalist tour guide has developed great sensibility to spot the night creators and will point them out with special flash light a laser pointer and radio communication The tour begins just before nightfall allowing us to see a wide variety of nocturnal critters.

Guided hikes or maps for do-it-yourselfers give access to the well-marked trails, waterfalls, rivers, and observation areas. You will see an amazing variety of flora and fauna. No one should leave Monteverde without having tried to see a "Quetzal", one of the most beautiful birds in the country. Monteverde also hosts the largest variety of butterflies and moths in the world.

Monteverde Reserve - Founded in 1972, the Monteverde Cloud Forest Biological Reserve is among the most famous reserves in the world for its biodiversity, conservation, contributions, and scientific researches. This 3,500 hectare of land holds 2.5% of the world's biodiversity, and it is one of the most important private reserves in Costa Rica. The geographical, topographical and climatic conditions have determined the surprising biodiversity found in the Monteverde Reserve. In this forest we can find four ecological "Live Zones" with different ecosystems for hundreds of species of mammals, birds,

butterflies, amphibians, reptiles, insects and arachnids, as well as a large variety of plants like mosses, vines and trees of the Cloud Forest.

Minimum Age: 6 years

Duration: Approximately half day activity

What to Bring: Light clothes, insect repellent, binoculars, camera and hiking shoes

What's Included: Transportation, tour guide and entrance fee

Transfer from Monteverde - to Manuel Antonio 4 hrs - You will be privately transferred to your next destination.

DESTINATION: Manuel Antonio is a small ocean side village with plenty of great places to stay - from extravagant luxury condos to cozy hideaway hotels tucked into nature. Famous for its national park, this tiny yet bustling town is located off Costa Rica's central Pacific coast just a stone's throw away from Quepos which is famous for sport fishing. The region is a treasure for biodiversity, attracting nature buffs, eco-travelers and adventure-seekers alike. Better yet, if you visit, you can soak up beautiful beaches and perfect waters. Without a doubt, Manuel Antonio lies within one of the country's most celebrated spots.
