Meet & Greet at San Jose Int'l Airport - Welcome! - A representative of the Costa Rica board of tourism, Canatur, will meet you after you have cleared immigration and provide you with name tags that identify you as a client of Way to Go Tours. After clearing customs, you will exit the terminal. There, you will see a representative of our destination management company, Destination Costa Rica, holding a placard with your name. You will be presented with your vouchers (except the ones included in your documents) and a general info kit. Pickup times for tours and transfers will be stamped on each voucher.

If in-country vouchers are printed with a different time than your documents, the times stamped on the vouchers supersede times listed below.

Transfer from San Jose Airport - to Arenal 2.5 Hrs - You will be picked up upon arrival and privately transferred to your accommodation.

DESTINATION: Arenal Volcano is approximately 3000 years old and has an elevation of 5500 feet. Though in a resting phase the volcano's geothermal activity heats the local mineral springs.

Surrounded by lush rain forest, the area offers the most touring options. The area is rich in natural attractions; experience thermomineral hot springs, waterfall hikes, horseback riding, birdwatching, biking, and boat tours on the Cano Negro.

The view of the Volcano from the hanging bridges over the forest makes a perfect combination for an unforgettable experience.

What to Bring: Long pants, hiking shoes, camera, binoculars, and during the rainy season bring a raincoat.

As a guest, you will have access to landscaped pools with great views of the volcano. The hot springs range from raging waterfalls to tranquil forest experiences. You can find the perfect pool for your mood. Also, enjoy Perdido Springs (Lost Springs), a connected system of trails and seven spring fed pools located within a forest canyon just a short walk from the lowest level of the Las Lagunas pools.

Whitewater Rafting Arenal (Class III/ IV) - Your Costa Rica rafting adventure tour begins with a 1.5 hour scenic drive that winds through plantations of papaya, pineapple and yucca at the base of the majestic Arenal Volcano. Once you reach the “put-in” spot, skillful, trained guides will go over the safety procedure and rules to prepare you for your paddling responsibilities. The Sarapiquí River winds through spectacular greenery, so between rapids you might be treated to sights of monkeys toucans and other Costa Rica wildlife species. At the halfway point you will take a break while your guides prepare some delicious snacks and tropical fruit on the river bank, so you can refuel, surrounded by the serene and majestic beauty of the rainforest.

Boat Transfer from Arenal to Monteverde - Arenal Lake crossing, half tour – half transfer is an scenic, fast and the newest way to go or come from La Fortuna to the Monteverde area. We start picking everybody from the hotels in La Fortuna for a 30 minutes drive to the Arenal Lake Dam. There we will aboard into a very comfortable and safe pontoon boat for a 30 to 40 minutes (approx.) ride to Río Chiquito, a little town at the other side of the lake. Once at Río Chiquito, we’ll leave the boat and make a short break to strength the legs, after, another 1 hour thirty minutes microbus ride to get to the hotels in the Monteverde area.

Night Walk - For those who wish to observe wonders hidden in the forest after dark we offer guided night hikes. At sunset, 80% of the forest life becomes active. Our naturalist tour guide has developed great sensibility to spot the night creatures and will point them out with special flash light a laser pointer and radio communication. The tour begins just before nightfall allowing us to see a wide variety of nocturnal critters.
