Day 2

Transfer from airport to Torres Del Paine - A representative from Explora Hotel will meet you at the airport. Your transfer is scheduled to depart the airport at 3:30p.m. Arrival at the hotel is at 9:30p.m. There will be a stop at Cerro Negro Ranch mid way during the transfer to the hotel. The stop at the ranch includes grilled Patagonian lamb with drinks, demonstration of sheep shearing and herding dogs and a visit of the ranch museum.

DESTINATION: Patagonia is a land shaped by nature. Eons of ice, water, wind, and tectonic forces have crafted this refuge for pure nature and adventure. Day 3

Optional Tour - Choose from a variety of half day or full day excursions. They also include various transportation modes — vehicle, trekking, horses, navigation, bike and climbing. Last but not least, they vary from easy to difficult depending on your fitness and expertise.

Day 4

Included Tour like:

We hike across the steppe of the reserve, surrounded by mountains, steppe and valleys. Along the way, you will be able to enjoy views of the Paine range, Cerro Obelisco, Laguna Jara and Sierra Baguales. The local flora is rich in coirón, matabarroza and ñirre, while the fauna includes guanacos, pumas, chingues, caranchos, condors and flamingoes, among others.

In this area you can see the history of the occupation of the province of Última Esperanza, due to the old estate that was here. You will also learn about the history of Lady Florence Dixie, the first woman explorer in Patagonia.

The gaucho and Patagonia are one, sharing temperance, silence, mystery and fascination.

Day 5

Included Tour like- We travel through the eastern sector of the park combining stretches in van with short walks. This sector is mainly characterized by the presence of animals such as guanacos, pumas and diversity of birds, as well as its extensive pampas, typical of the Patagonian steppe. First we visit the Nordenskjöld Lake viewpoint and the Paine Grande waterfall, then we travel by van to the Los Cisnes Lagoon and finally to the Amarga Lagoon.

*Available only select months of the year according to the activity of the estancieros. Coordinated at the destination.

Only the Patagonian steppe is able to endure the relentless blow of the southern winds.

Included Tour like- We depart from the stables and ride across rivers, forests and pampas as we ascend towards the viewpoint of the Negra Lagoon. On the way we pass by several lagoons, ideal for spotting different species of birds such as Quiltehues or Magellanic geese.
