Day 2: Copenhagen

On this tour, your private driver and licensed guide will take you to the main sights that give Copenhagen its old world charm.

You'll pass by Ny Carlsberg Glyptotek, Tivoli Gardens, the world's oldest Royal Stock Exchange, and Christiansborg Castle, which today houses the Danish Parliament and the Supreme Court.

Next, you'll visit the charming harbor, Nyhavn, before reaching Amalienborg Castle, the prime residence of the Danish Royal family. You'll also pass by Rosenborg Castle where the Royal collections, including the Crown Jewels, are protected by the Royal Guard.

And of course, no tour of Copenhagen would be complete without visiting The Little Mermaid, inspired by Hans Christian Andersen's fairytale.

Day 3: Copenhagen

On this tour, your private driver and local guide will take you through beautiful North Zealand, visiting some of Denmark's most beloved and famous landmarks.

Your first destination is Frederiksborg Castle in Hillerød. This elegant Dutch Renaissance structure serves as the National Museum of History and is best known for its outstanding collection of portraits.

Not far from here, you'll make a brief stop at the Royal Family's summer residence, Fredensborg Palace.

Heading further north through the picturesque countryside, you'll reach the town of Elsinore. Here you'll find Kronborg Castle, a UNESCO-listed World Heritage Site and the setting for William Shakespeare's infamous play, Hamlet.

Continuing back towards Copenhagen, you'll drive along the coastal road. Also known as the Danish Riviera, the coastal road provides a lovely view of the sea between Denmark and Sweden, as well taking you through some very lavish residential areas.

Entrance - Frederiksborg Castle

Frederiksborg Castle, situated in Hillerød, is the largest Renaissance palace in Scandinavia. This impressive and unrivalled castle was built in the first decades of the 17th century by the legendary Danish King Christian IV and it is now a museum of Danish national history.

12:00 Entrance FIT - Louisiana Museum of Modern Art

Louisiana is the most visited art museum in Denmark, and has an extensive collection of modern and contemporary art, dating from World War II to the present day; in addition, it has a comprehensive programme of special exhibitions. The museum is also acknowledged as a milestone in modern Danish architecture, and is noted for its synthesis of art, architecture, and landscape.

The museum is included in the Patricia Schultz book 1,000 Places to See Before You Die and ranks 85th on a list of the most visited art museums in the world (2011).

Day 4: Copenhagen

10:00 Local guide for 5 hours

Go on a treasure hunt to find The Six Forgotten Giants in the western municipalities of Copenhagen: Rødovre, Hvidovre, Vallensbæk, Ishøj, Albertslund and Høje Taastrup.

All six sculptures are made from scrap wood with the help of local volunteers, and is the first chapter of Thomas Dambo's ongoing story: "The great story of the little people and the giant trolls".

The project wants to bring art out of the museum, show the beautiful and often overlooked nature spots, and at the same time give an exciting and different experience.

Nordic Dinner Private Class

Enjoy an evening of learning and exploring the Danish and Nordic kitchen. With an inspiring array of local ingredients, seasonal foods and foraged delicacies, create a three course meal inspired by traditional Danish dishes, but fused with the New Nordic cuisine. 11:00 Entrance - Viking Ship Museum Roskilde

The Viking Ship Museum in Roskilde is the Danish museum for ships, seafaring and boatbuilding culture in ancient and medieval times. The Viking Ship Hall, the oldest part of the museum, was opened in 1969. It was designed as a large showcase to display the five Viking ships found at Skuldelev. The hall also houses special temporary exhibitions and a cinema, where a film about the excavation of the ships is shown.

17:00 Entrance - H. C. Andersens House

A visit to H.C. Andersen House is a surprising and fascinating journey into the author's creative universe – and his world-famous fairy tales. Beauty merges with imagination at the museum, where world-class architecture and spaces bring nature indoors, and provoke us to turn things on their head and speculate about today and tomorrow.

Via sound, light, space and scenery designed in collaboration with 12 international artists, in this innovative exhibition, it is possible experience Andersen and his works speaking to us.

Den Gamle By (The Old Town) is a national open-air museum of urban history and culture in Denmark through three centuries. The museum consists of more than 75 historic houses relocated from all over Denmark.

Besides the historic houses and the apartments in the 1974 section, there are more than 34 workshops and shops as well as a pharmacy, a school, a post office, a telephone exchange, a jazz bar and much more. Furthermore the museum has its own theater, the Elsinore Theatre, which is used for opera, chamber concerts, festivals etc.

Grenen is the most popular destination when visiting Skagen. Grenen is the place where the Baltic Sea and the North Sea, which shows in lively waves and strong currents. Råbjerg Mile, North Jutland's Sahara desert, and the sand-covered church, Den Tilsandede Kirke, are also very popular outdoor nature experiences

Copenhagen Strand is located in an 1869 warehouse. Each guest room has a minibar, satellite TV and a work desk.

There is a TV lounge and Wi-Fi is free in all public areas.

Only 400 m from Copenhagen Strand is the Kongens Nytorv Metro Station, and Copenhagen water buses stop nearby. Nearby attractions include the Amalienborg castle, which is a 10-minute walk away.
