Upon arrival, you will be met by your guide and depart on your first game drive. At the conclusion of your game drive, you will arrive at your accommodation, Tawi Cottages where you have time to check in, enjoy lunch and relax.

Tawi Lodge is located on a private conservancy of 6,000 acres just five minutes from Kimana Gate, the eastern entrance to Amboseli National Park, at the foot of Mount Kilimanjaro. Upon arrival, you will be met by your guide and embark on a game drive that concludes at your accommodation for the following two nights, Saruni Samburu.

Saruni Samburu commands some of the best views in Kenya. It's a much-loved design lodge perched on top of a spectacular viewpoint, its villas and its swimming pools overlook waterholes where the famous Samburu elephant, leopard, reticulated giraffe and Grevy zebra gather to drink.
