Your expedition begins in South Florida

October 20 – 22

Galapagos Islands, Ecuador

The Galápagos Islands offer landscapes and wildlife found nowhere else on earth

Fly from Miami to Guayaquil, Ecuador aboard the private jet. We will then transfer to a commercial buyout flight for the island of Baltra in the Galápagos, where we will enjoy overnights on land.

October 23 – 25

Mendoza Wine Country, Argentina

Travel outside Mendoza to the land of sunshine and wine

A region of foothills and high plains on the eastern fringes of the Andes mountain range, this area features acres upon acres of grapevines backed by dramatic mountain peaks. Our group will split here and spend time enjoying tastings and activities near each of the respective hotels.

October 26 – 28

Patagonia, Chile

Discover the majestic beauty of Torres del Paine National Park in Patagonia

From serrated mountain peaks to translucent waters and ice-blue glaciers, Patagonia's Torres del Paine is a 700-square-mile wonderland of breathtaking contrasts. We will take the private jet to Punta Arenas, and then take a long scenic drive to Puerto Natales, stopping for lunch at a traditional estancia (ranch). Weather permitting, we will take a charter flight back from Puerto Natales to Punta Arenas. (If weather does not permit, we will drive.) Explore one of the largest and most impressive of Chile's National Parks.

October 29 – 30

Santa Cruz and Uyuni Salt Flats, Bolivia

Santa Cruz de la Sierra is the gateway to spectacular Uyuni Salt Flats

Base out of this tropical lowland city for the chance to visit the amazing UNESCO-listed Uyuni Salt Flats. You will also get to explore this historic city, founded in 1561.

Bogota, Colombia
