### Athens Morning Tour including Acropolis Museum

This tour gives you an opportunity to observe the striking contrasts that make Athens such a fascinating city. Your expert guides will take you to see the Panathenaic Stadium where the first Olympic Games of modern times were held in 1896 (short stop). Continue and pass by the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the Hadrian's Arch, the Parliament and the memorial to the Unknown Soldier, the Academy, the University, the National Library, the Constitution Square Syntagma. On the Acropolis visit the Architectural Masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: The Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and finally "the harmony between material and spirit", the monument that "puts order in the mind", the Parthenon. Continue and visit the place where at last the statues found their home and admire the wonders of the classical era: The new Acropolis museum.

Day 6

Private Half-Day los Tour

On this private half-day tour, you will start by visiting los Chora or los Town, the main village, located on the western side of the island. See the traditional windmills of los, surrounded by beautiful, colourful gardens. There are a total of 12 traditional windmills with 3 of them completely restored. These charming structures serve as a reminder of the past when the islanders used the power of the wind in everyday life. Then, take a stroll around the picturesque village with its characteristic alleyways, flat-roofed house and narrow stone paved streets winding like a labyrinth.

Next stop is to the church of Panagia Gremiotissa, located at the highest point of Chora. This picture perfect church was built in 1797 AD and owes its name to its rocky location. From this wonderful landmark, you will enjoy a panoramic view of the town.

The tour continues to a visit to the open Theater Odysseas Elytis, named after the Greek Nobel Prize winning poet and Homer's Tomb, the allegedly rest place of the famous ancient Greek poet. The last stop will be to Palaiokastro, a castle built at an altitude of 275 meters to protect the island from the pirates, where we will enjoy breathtaking views.

The first stop is the The Church of Our Lady of 100 Doors (or Panagia Ekatonapyliani), located in the capital city of Parikia, the oldest early Christian monument in Greece. Next, head outside of the town to Naousa, a beautifully preserved fishing village, especially popular in the summertime known as a stylish resort and visitor destination. From cosmopolitan to rural, visit to a family-run farm where you will get introduced to local food and an explanation of the growing and harvesting processes. Free time to wander in this eco-friendly farm to enjoy the landscape and views. Then, in Prodromos, see how the locals live! One of the most picturesque villages comprising of whitewashed houses, yards with colourful flowers and narrow paths lined with pavestones accessible on foot through the village gates. Walking through the quaint passages, you will come across a traditional tavern where typical Parian dishes are prepared and served daily. Enjoy a tasting of one of the homemade "mezze" Parians love! Then, drive a short distance to the village of Kostos, an 'off the beaten

path' village in the mountains. The tour's last stop is at its "kafenio"! A spot where the older generation get together to discuss their differences in local politics, discuss sports and play backgammon. Take a coffee and learn how to prepare your own when back home. After this day full of new sights, sounds and experiences, drive back to your hotel to relax and remember the beauty of Paros.
