

Day 1 - Melbourne

On arrival in Melbourne, you will be met and transferred to your accommodation by private vehicle for a 3-night stay. The remainder of your day is free to explore the city center at leisure.

Day 2 - Melbourne (B,L)

Travel from Melbourne to the Yarra Valley for a full day wine touring. Visit Greenstone Vineyards where the Winery and Cellar Door are nestled into the base of the Christmas Hills for tastings. Indulge in a guided tasting session at Balgownie Estate tasting table. Make your selection of wine for lunch and take your complimentary glass of wine to the eatery. Lunch includes main meal, a glass of Balgownie Estate wine & tea or coffee. Continue to Yering Farm, where you will experience traditionally made wines. Soumah of Yarra Valley is the next stop. Specializing in wine styles and varieties typical of northern Italy and south-eastern France, discover their award-winning Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

Day 3 - Melbourne (B)

Today, experience this majestic coastal drive-in style on a small group and enjoy time to relax and fully appreciate the wonders of this world-famous touring route. with a local food expert. Visit stallholders, taste delicious samples that represent the multicultural community of South Australia and the clean and green produce harvested from local farms and oceans, and experience the exciting buzz of the market.

This afternoon, make your way to Penfolds Magill Estate and join a member of the Penfolds team on a journey through the foundation of Penfolds as Australia's leading red wine producer. Your tour starts with a visit to the Grange Cottage; the original home of Dr Christopher and Mary Penfold before viewing the Magill Estate winery, vintage cellar, and underground drives where you will discover the gems hidden within. Your tour concludes with an intimate tasting of Penfolds Most awarded and sought after wines including one vintage of Grange.

Day 6 - Adelaide (B,L)

Transfer by coach from Adelaide to Cape Jervis taking in the picturesque Fleurieu Peninsula with its vineyards, coastal views and rolling hills. On arrival, board the ferry for the 45-minute crossing to Penneshaw on Kangaroo Island. On arrival, board the coach where your local driver/guide will take you on a tasting tour of Kangaroo Island's popular tourism spots. Your first official stop will be the fascinating Birds of Prey Presentation at Raptor Domain for an educational, interactive, and inspiring experience. The only "Free Flight" Birds of Prey display in South Australia, it is thought by many to be the most interactive Birds of Prey presentation in Australia. Next, travel to Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery for a delicious lunch followed by an introductory talk about the history of the oil distillery and take a guided tour. You may choose to taste Kangaroo Island Ciders' range of Colony Cove products including Apple Sparkler and Cider (additional cost). Finish off with some free time in their souvenir shop where you will find an assortment of Eucalyptus products. Your next stop is Clifford's Honey Farm, where you'll enjoy an informative guided tour of the honey room where you will learn about the extraction process, taste a honey soft drink, and have the option to sample the Drunken Drone Brewery's Honey Wheat Ale. In the farm gate shop, you can see a working beehive where you can try to spot the Queen bee. There are different varieties of pure Kangaroo Island Ligurian honey and beauty products to purchase as well as their famous honey ice-cream. Continue to Pennington Bay, a spectacular beach on the south coast of Kangaroo Island for a photo opportunity before arriving at your final stop False Cape Wines Cellar Door. This stunning new cellar door is made from recycled wood, jetty timbers and limestone sourced on the property. Here you can take part in a structured wine tasting while enjoying the peaceful views of the surrounding vineyards. Your tour ends at the Penneshaw Hotel where you have ample time to have dinner (own expense) before returning to the Penneshaw Ferry Terminal for your ferry and coach transfer back to Adelaide.
