desert scenery | Hike around the spectacular Mescal Mountain, Doe Mountain and Boynton Vortex | Explore Tuzigoot National Monument, a hilltop pueblo built a thousand years ago | Admire beautiful vineyards as you bike through the Verde Valley | Kayak in the Verde River surrounded by the natural beauty of Sycamore Canyon | A hike on Airport Mesa leads to a spectacular 360-degree view of Sedona from Table Top Mountain.
