

Day 1 Private Transfer to Taormina Hotel

Welcome to Italy! After landing at Catania Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. A private transfer will escort you and your luggage to your Taormina hotel.

Day 2 Taormina

Visit the hilltop town of Taormina on the east coast of Sicily. Enjoy its spectacular views of Giardini Naxos and Mount Etna, the largest active volcano in Europe. Visit the city center and the Greek and Roman Amphitheater. Enjoy some time at leisure for shopping and lunch.

Savoca and D'Agro Valley

Explore the picturesque villages of Savoca and D'Agro Valley, where filming took place for the famed Godfather film trilogy. Like many small towns in the Messina area, they are perched on top of the mountains and offer spectacular views of the Ionian coast. From Forza d'Agro you can admire even the Queen of the Ionian Sea, the beautiful Taormina!

Day 3 Mount Etna

Mount Etna & Zafferana Honey Tasting

Explore the slopes of Mount Etna, the highest Mediterranean island mountain and the most active stratovolcano in the world and enjoy a honey-tasting experience in Zafferana along the way. Continue climbing to 6,000 feet, where you can enjoy the best views, as you drive through the fertile slopes and villages that sit on ancient volcanic eruptions.

Day 4 Taormina - Tropea

Calabria

Board a ferry to cross the straits of Messina into the mythological Scilla and explore the very southern point of the Italian peninsula, Calabria. It occupies the "toe" of the country's boot-shaped peninsula. It's a sun-baked region of rugged mountains, old-fashioned villages and dramatic coastline, with many popular beaches.

Travel to Tropea

Travel to Tropea, on the Tyrennian coast of Calabria; one of the most spectacular seaside towns in the Mediterranean.

Overnight: Villa Paola, Tropea

Suspended between the bright blue of the sky and the sea of Calabria, and just a few minutes from the center of Tropea, Villa Paola is a charming residence with a centuries-long history.

Day 5 Tropea - Puglia

Travel to Puglia through Mt. Vesuvius

Depart for Puglia, driving through the slopes of Mount Vesuvius. Visit a local winery along the way for a wine tasting session to sample some traditional wines of the region.

Conversano

Travel next to the beautiful town of Conversano, an ancient agricultural center built on a hill located south of Bari. While traveling through this region, you will see many olive groves, grape vines, and cherry trees. Conversano is famous for its excellent cherries.

Day 6 Alberobello

Visit Alberobello, Puglia's picture postcard town, famous for its conical roofed houses, also known as "trulli". This is an UNESCO World Heritage site with narrow pedestrian streets, little shops selling local produce, nice outdoor cafes and trattorias

Olive Oil Farm

Visit a traditional working olive oil farm. Experience the process of making the decadent oil and taste the final product.

Day 7 Lecce - Ostuni

Lecce Guided Tour

Embark on a guided tour with a local guide who will introduce you to the beauty of Lecce. Built of the local soft creamy limestone with dazzling architectural surprises around every corner, Lecce is a minor Baroque masterpiece. Its spider's web of streets that offer a kaleidoscopic mix of long-range vistas, alluring glimpses and playful perspectives, have long enchanted visitors.

Ostuni

Stop at the city of Ostuni known for its whitewashed old town. Walk through the white houses that dominate much of the area. Ostuni Cathedral combines Gothic, Romanesque and Byzantine elements, while the arched Porta San Demetrio is one of two remaining medieval gates.

Day 8 Puglia - Minori

Travel to the Amalfi Coast

Journey to the Amalfi Coast, a gorgeous stretch of rugged coastline along the Mediterranean with breathtaking views and landscapes to take-in along the way.
