Day 2 Porto

Porto Walking Tour and Private visit to Lello Library before opening hours.

8:15 AM Start Time - Meeting Point: At Hotel

Walk the narrow streets of Porto with a local friendly tour guide who will reveal all its secrets and hidden gems in a pleasant and fun stroll.

Discover why this small city in the north of Portugal was, for many centuries, one of the most important cities in the world, and from here, the Portuguese ruled world's navigation routes and trade.

Find out about "Henry - the Navigator" and "Dom Pedro I - King of Portugal and Emperor of Brazil" and Port Wine. Or just learn about our culture and traditions, and how we, the "tripe people" live. (Porto's locals are called "tripe people" "Tripeiros" in Portuguese)

You will visit a lot of beautiful places and monuments with your guide. Some of these places include: Cathedral, Clerigos Tower, São Bento train station, Lello Bookshop, river front, and Eiffel's iron bridges.

Enjoy Lello library before opening hours.

Livraria Lello was founded in 1869 by the French publisher and bookseller Ernesto Chardron. At the time, it was called Livraria Internacional de Ernesto Chardron and was steps away from its current location, in Rua dos Clérigos. After the owner's death, the business passed into the hands of Lugan & Genelioux, which expanded it. In 1894, the bookstore was sold to Josè Lello, who owned commercial space in Rua do Almada. A few years later, Josè entered into partnership with his brother (irmão, in Portuguese) Antonio and hence the name Lello e Irmão.

The brothers decided to change their identity to create a literary salon for men of culture of the time. The library, as we know it today, was inaugurated on 13 January 1906 and collected the approval of the main Portuguese intellectuals and politicians. «Erecting a temple to the cult of ideas is an act of merit that, due to its results, will link the names Lello and Irmão to national recognition», declares the writer and diplomat Abel Botelho, at the inauguration ceremony. The project is not entrusted to an architect but to the engineer Francisco Xavier Esteves, known for being a fan of literature he realizes an eclectic building that merges neo gothic influences with liberty. It was named property of public interest in 1994.

This will be a great insight into Porto's food, history, architecture, and culture. You will also have an overview of the old Jewish Porto History.

Day 3 Porto

Coimbra + Aveiro Day Trip

9:00 AM Start Time - Meeting Point: At your hotel

First, you'll go to Coimbra where you'll have a complete visit to the University of Coimbra which is the oldest university in Portugal and one of the oldest in Europe, followed by a walk downhill through the old neighborhood to the commercial area of the city. Visit the church of Santa Cruz, that holds the tombs of Portugal's 1st and 2nd kings.

After the city center, we'll head towards the enchanted "Jardim das Lagrimas" garden with a short visit. There you'll take a lunch on your own at "Arcadas Gastro Bar".

In Aveiro, you'll have a visit to the Costa Nova area (beach area in a peninsula/island surrounded by the sea and a lagoon), where the guests will take lots of pictures of the fisherman's typical houses. The tour proceeds to the center of Aveiro, stopping first at the sea salt production fields (salines), and then the canals and the gondolas that make Aveiro "the Venice of Portugal". All this with the Art Noveau houses in the city. In Aveiro, there's always the option (already included) for the cruise in the canals.

What's included? 9-hours with an expert local guide, transportation, entrances fees to the University of Coimbra + Joanina Library, church of Sta Cruz, tasting of Ovos Moles and shared cruise for the canals.

Day 4 Porto to Douro Valley

Private Visit to a Family Owned Collection and Serralves Foundation.

8:30 Start time - Meeting Point: At your hotel

Your driver will pick you up and drive you to the private house we will be at the house around 9 AM.

Private visit to a family owned Villa.

This Portuguese family owns the Faience, ceramic, pottery, private and greatest collection from an old significant factory from Porto, one of the most significant companies in Portugal.

The house belongs to the last owner of the Carvalhinho Company, that recently passed away, as well, as his wife. This is his private and greatest collection of the carvalhinho pieces in the country.

Founded in 1841 the Cerâmica do Carvalhinho Factory used to produce shaped/molded faience, tiles and ceramics. Fábrica de Cerâmica do Carvalhinho was an important company in the 1950s. Its real value as an industrial organization has become an authentic "ex-libris" of the Portuguese ceramic industry.

Located first in Porto and later on in Vila Nova de Gaia, it produced notable pieces of national ceramics, such as white or colored tiles, but above all famous and unmistakable old-style tiles, copied in Convents, Monasteries and Manor Houses, from the 17th and 18th centuries, where there are scattered valuable examples. The other specialty is the well-known artistic faience / earthenware from Fábrica do Carvalhinho, hand-painted, piece by piece, with a high level of perfection.

This place is not opened to visits for the general public.

After this visit we will head to the Serralves Foundation.

Located in the city of Porto, the Foundation has a rich historical and cultural heritage, including the Museum, designed by the architect Álvaro Siza, winner of the 1992 Pritzker Prize, the Serralves Villa, a unique example of art deco architecture, and the Serralves Park, designed by the French architect Jacques Greber, which was awarded the "Henry Ford Prize for the Preservation of the Environment" in 1997.

In 2012, Serralves' Park and buildings were jointly classified as a "National Monument". This is the most important heritage classification level, and was granted in recognition of Serralves' cultural, architectural and landscape value and the investment in the enhancement, animation and dissemination of the Foundation's heritage assets.

Serralves aims to be recognized nationally and internationally as a centre of excellence in the field of contemporary art and, in general, in terms of reflection about key contemporary social issues, thus promoting the diversity of the cultural offer, through an innovative intervention that will steadily attract diverse audiences and induce greater community support.

What's included: 4 hour activity, Private visit to a family owned private collection, Serralves Foundation Entrance Fees, Transportation.

Douro Valley is the oldest demarcated wine region, with a denomination of origin, in the world. Land of the Port Wine, its heritage belongs not only to the Portuguese, but also to the British. Still?

This is really a hidden place surrounded and protected by mountains that, besides preserving nature and people's simplicity, also creates the perfect micro climate necessary to grow the Port Wine grape varieties (all native).

Douro started to produce extremely good red wines that were shipped out, from Porto. But, then Port Wine happened ... Since then, an industry was born changing the life of Douro and Porto until today.

The Girona Cathedral, dedicated to Santa Maria, is located at the highest point in the city and has the widest Gothic nave in the world.

To discover Sitges' origins you have take a walk around its old quarter. You'll discover remains of ancient ramparts, the Raco de la Calma (Quiet Corner), the old fishermen's homes, the cannon.
