Kick off your journey with a festive welcome dinner at Four Seasons Hotel Miami. Meet your fellow travelers and dedicated expedition staff, and then settle in for a night's rest before the adventures ahead. We depart for Guatemala the next morning.

November 30 - December 1

Antigua, Guatemala

The colorful city of Antigua is a UNESCO World Heritage site

Filled with candy-colored buildings and cobblestone streets, Antigua was Guatemala's political and cultural capital for 230 years. This city offers an enchanting mix of colonial history, charming architecture and a vibrant culinary scene to discover, as well as access to Guatemala's majestic volcanoes.

December 2 – 4

Galapagos Islands, Ecuador

The Galápagos Islands offer landscapes and wildlife found nowhere else on earth

Fly from Guatemala to Guayaquil, Ecuador, aboard the private jet. We will then transfer to a commercial buyout flight for the island of Baltra in the Galápagos, where we take a ferry to nearby Santa Cruz Island to enjoy overnights on land.

December 5 – 6

Iguacu Falls, Brazil

Iguaçu Falls is one of nature's most impressive spectacles

The Iguazu River, which means "big water" in the Guaraní language, runs through a gauntlet of islands to finally plunge from a lava cliff in a series of 275 interlinking waterfalls on the border of Brazil and Argentina.

December 7 – 9

Torres del Paine, Chile

Seek out wild pumas in Torres del Paine National Park

Patagonia's Torres del Paine is a 700-square-mile wonderland of serrated mountain peaks, translucent waters and ice-blue glaciers. We will travel on the private jet to Punta Arenas and then take a long scenic drive to Puerto Natales. Explore one of Chile's largest and most impressive national parks while searching for its resident big cats—wild pumas—with wildlife experts. Weather permitting, we will take a charter flight from Puerto Natales to El Calafate. (If weather does not permit, we will travel there by scenic drive.)

December 10 – 12

El Calafate, Argentina

Immerse yourself in the glacial landscapes of Argentine Patagonia

Adventurers from around the globe and throughout the centuries have made their way to this storied land at the end of the continent. Venture into Los Glaciares National Park, where the forces of fire and ice work to sculpt dramatic landscapes that include cobalt lakes, massive glaciers and soaring Andean peaks.

December 13 – 15

Atacama Desert, Chile

The barren and beautiful landscape of Atacama invites adventure

Set between the low coastal mountains and the Andean foothills of northern Chile, the Atacama Desert is a land of serrated peaks and arid valleys just waiting to be explored.

December 16 – 17

Peninsula Papagayo, Costa Rica

Embrace Costa Rica's "pura vida" lifestyle

Spend two nights at an idyllic Four Seasons retreat on the serene Peninsula Papagayo. Whether you're seeking adventure or escaping to the beach, the possibilities are endless in this nature paradise of golden shores and tropical jungles.
